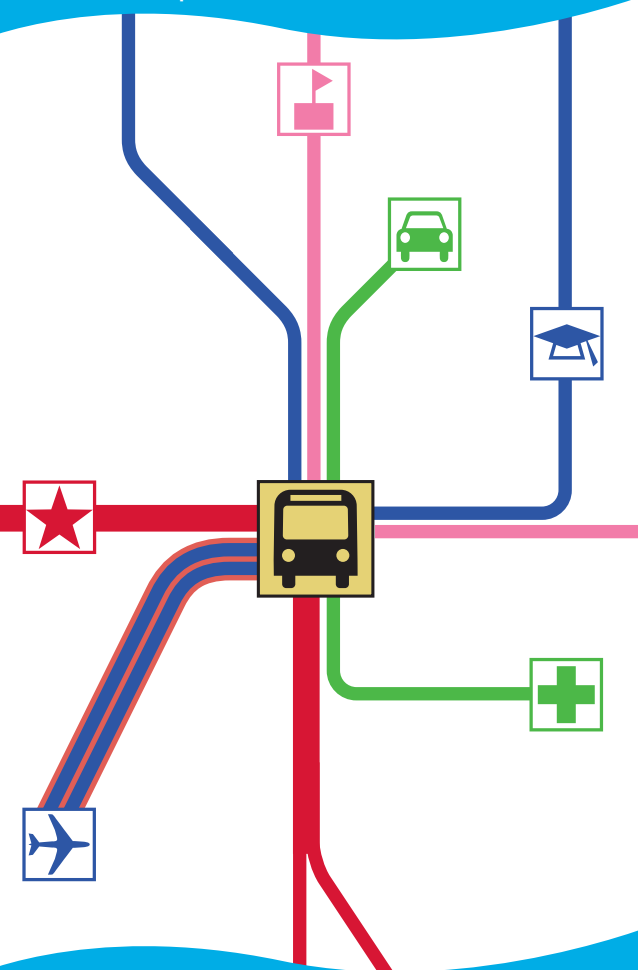

FARE INFORMATION

STA fares subject to change
Fareboxes accept U.S. coins and dollar bills; 31-Day, Monthly, Two-Hour, Day, Free Ride passes and Smart Cards. No pennies.
Monday to Friday, 7:00 am - 6:00 pm
Saturday, Noon - 5:00 pm

Table with columns: RIDER (YOUTH, ADULT, REDUCED FARE, PARATRANSIT), CASH, 2-HOUR PASS, DAY PASS, 7-DAY PASS, 31-DAY PASS. Values range from \$2.00 to \$40.00.

Children age 5 and under ride free and must be accompanied by a person paying full fare (maximum of 3 children).

Reduced Fare ID Card Requirements

- 1 Must be 65 years of age or older. Proof of age must be presented, or;
2 Qualifying disability - application form to be completed by a health care professional, or;
3 A valid Medicare card issued by the Social Security Administration.

* You must have a Reduced Fare ID Card or STA Paratransit ID Card to pay the reduced fare of \$1.00. This Card must be shown with your reduced fare (cash or pass) each time you board the bus.

Two-Hour Passes/Day Passes

Ask your driver for a Two-Hour Pass (free with paid fare) or a Day Pass before paying your fare. Passes issued from the farebox are good for multiple rides for the designated time—just swipe it through the magnetic reader on the farebox.

PARK & RIDE LOTS

RULES OF THE ROAD

- No tobacco or e-cigarette use.
• Consumption of beverages allowed only in approved containers with resealable lids.
• No eating.
• No foul language.
• Shoes and shirts are required.
• All animals must be kept in appropriate containers with absorbent materials in the carrier floor, except for service animals accompanying passengers who are disabled.
• When listening to radios or playback devices earphones must be worn.
• Non-collapsible strollers, baby buggies and carts block the aisle and therefore must be prohibited.
• Collapse strollers or carts before boarding.
• No gasoline, paint, or other flammable liquids are allowed on the bus.
• No explosives or corrosives are allowed.
• No loud, raucous, unruly, aggressive, violent, harmful or harassing behavior is allowed on the bus.
• Bicycles are allowed only on the front of the bus on the racks.
