Improving Safety & Supporting Area Redevelopment

Project Description

In close collaboration with the Community Colleges of Spokane, the new Spokane Falls Station, located at Spokane Falls Community College (SFCC), is a key piece of an effort to improve safety and transform the area into a walkable, mixed-use district. The new transit station will relocate transit stops from Fort George Wright Drive to the western portion of campus. A new traffic signal will accommodate bus and traffic access to the campus. The transit station will include:

- Off-street passenger boarding area
- Shelters and other passenger amenities
- Revised campus driveways to accommodate bus traffic
- Improve safety and traffic access to campus

Budget & Timeline

Estimated project cost **\$2.96 million**

Local Funds **\$830,000**

WA State Regional Mobility Grant **\$2.13 million**

Construction is anticipated to begin Spring 2019

Anticipated to be complete Fall 2019

- Improved passenger safety and comfort
- Better transit visibility to encourage student and faculty ridership
- More space for growing ridership
- Improved access to higher education
- Leverage for planned City street investments
- Support for the West Hills' neighborhood vision
