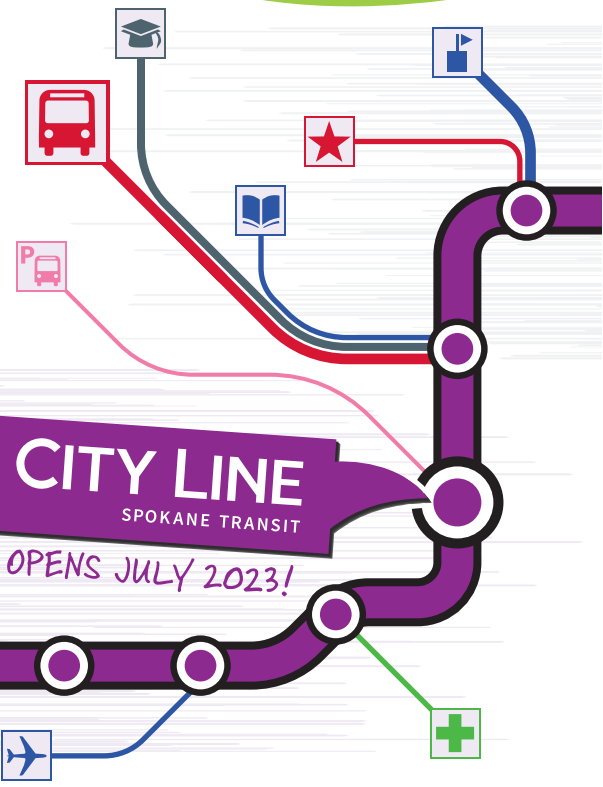

Cash Fares

Fareboxes accept US coins and dollar bills. No pennies. Neither the coach operator nor the fareboxes can provide change. Please have fare ready prior to boarding.

Two-Hour Passes

Ask your driver for a Two-Hour Pass (free with paid fare) before paying your fare. Passes issued from the farebox are good for multiple rides for the designated time – just swipe it through the magnetic reader on the farebox.

Contactless Payments

Contactless Visa, MasterCard, Discover, Apple Pay and Google Pay are accepted by tapping the validator upon boarding.

Reduced and Zero-Fare

Spokane Transit offers discounted fares on our Fixed Route services through a variety of Reduced and Zero-Fare programs.

- Honored Rider** – 50% discount age 60 and older and individuals with disabilities
- Stars & Stripes** – 50% discount for active-duty military personnel and veterans
- Student** – 20% discount on monthly fare cap
- Riders License** – Unlimited free rides for Connect card holders ages 6-18

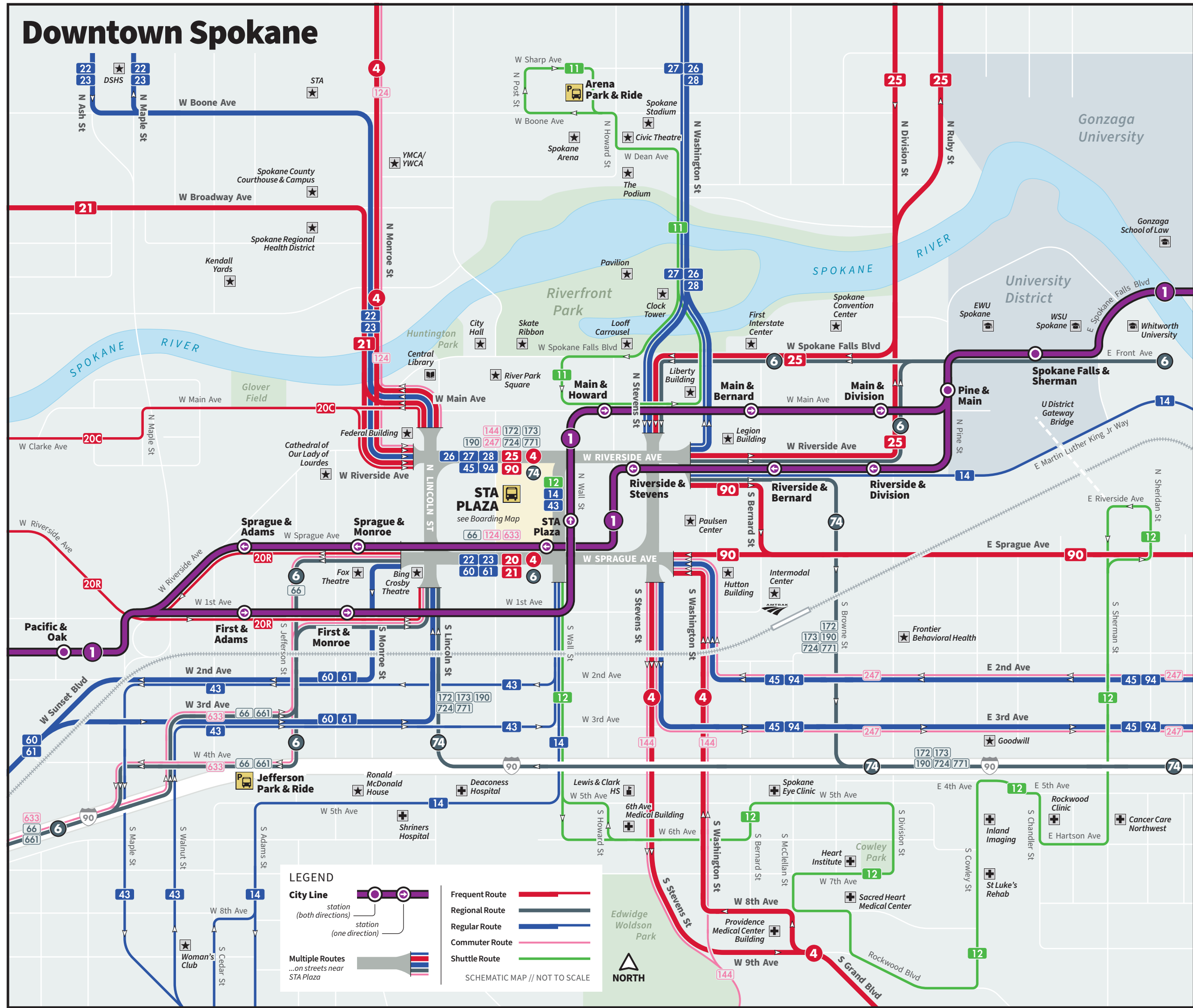

Vanpool

Vanpool is just like carpooling, but with a vehicle maintained by STA. A group of at least 3 people who live and work near each other commute together in an STA van to save money. More information can be found at spokanetransit.com/vanpool

Bikes on Buses

Buses have bike racks to transport up to three bikes. More information about how to ride with your bike can be found at spokanetransit.com

Rules of Conduct

- No tobacco or e-cigarette use.
- Consumption of beverages allowed only in approved containers with resealable lids.
- No eating.
- No foul language.
- Shoes and shirts are required.
- All animals must be kept in appropriate containers with absorbent materials in the carrier floor, except for service animals accompanying passengers who are disabled.
- When listening to radios or playback devices earphones must be worn.
- Non-collapsible strollers, baby buggies and carts block the aisle and therefore must be prohibited.
- Collapse strollers or carts before boarding.
- No gasoline or other flammable liquids are allowed on the bus.
- No explosives or corrosives are allowed.
- No loud, raucous, unruly, aggressive, violent, harmful or harassing behavior is allowed on the bus.
- Bicycles are allowed only on dedicated bike racks.
