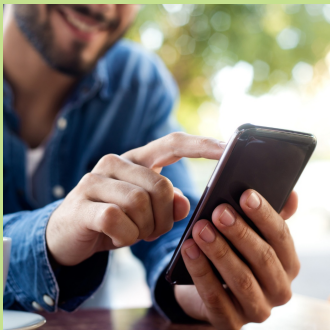

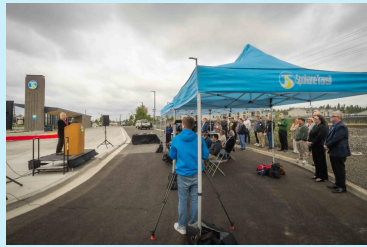


Mirabeau Transit Center Ribbon Cutting

STA celebrated the opening of the new Mirabeau Transit Center with a ribbon cutting on May 14. Located in Spokane Valley, the modern facility features real-time arrival displays, covered platforms, bike racks, and a signature spire visible from I-90. It will serve as an important connection point for Route 7 when service



launches this fall. Guest speakers at the ribbon cutting included Spokane Valley Mayor and STA Board Chair Pam Haley and Washington State Department of Transportation Regional Administrator Charlene Kay, who both praised the project as a key investment in regional mobility, access, and High Performance Transit.

Transit Development Plan Open Houses

STA is hosting an **open house** for the Transit Development Plan (TDP) on Monday, June

9, from 4 pm - 6 pm at the STA Plaza Rotunda on the first floor at 701 W Riverside Ave. The TDP is a six-year planning tool that guides service and capital improvements. Attendees can learn more, ask questions, and provide input to help shape future transit decisions. A **virtual open house** will be held on Thursday, June 5, from 5:30 pm - 6:30 pm. Argonne Station Open House

STA will host a public open house for Argonne Station on Wednesday, June 18, from 4 pm - 6 pm at the Spokane Valley Library at 22 N Herald Rd. Attendees can view preliminary designs, renderings, and project details, ask questions, and share feedback. Representatives from STA, the Washington State Department of Transportation, and the City of Spokane Valley will be available.
